Portfolio Allocation

For the month of March, the portfolio had 10% allocations to each of U.S., Canadian, Japanese, Eurozone, and emerging market equities. It also had 10% exposures to U.S. preferred shares and emerging market sovereign bonds. The remaining 30% of the portfolio was invested in short term U.S. investment grade bonds.

In terms of performance attribution, the portfolio's allocation to U.S. stocks rose 3.3%, its exposure to Canadian shares advanced 3.7%, its position in Japanese equities gained 3.2%, its allocation to Eurozone stocks rose 3.8%, and its exposure to emerging market companies rose 2.7%

On the non-equity side, the portfolio's exposure to U.S. preferred shares rose 0.7%, its position in emerging market sovereign bonds rose 2.0%, and its allocation to short term U.S. investment grade bonds advanced 0.7%.
